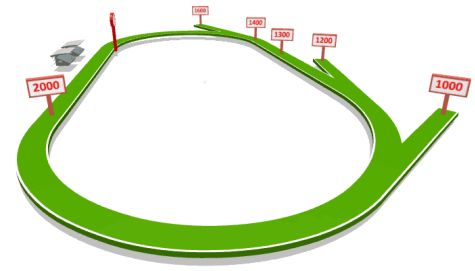

Race Analysis: Happy to have a bet here and throw up the local Into The Fire. He brings in the highest recent RAS Rating which was produced over this course and distance in very similar conditions. He held his own two back before disappointing most recently, but he's been freshened since and back to the scene of the crime makes him very appealing. There's not much between The Mooch and Baby Daisy on their recent performances. Baby Daisy is more likely to be close to the speed with The Mooch back in the run under JVO as she usually is - though she does come back in grade today. Recent ratings suggest there can't be much between them. Vainstream is not without a chance, and Insane Volt must go into the mix following a good win last start. This is different again but the rating stacks up.

Race Analysis: Could well end up with egg on my face - though I'm willing to take on Pure Melody here. Out to 2000m for the first time doesn't look an issue, though there isn't much between her and Knight Of Rhodes on the ratings, but there may be plenty between them in the run. She was sound late in the Wagga Guineas last week, but she's likely to end up back in the run again, whereas Knight Of Rhodes comes through a strong 2000m event here where the form has worked out very well. Boudvillain sticks with him and he'll be tough to run down as he still possesses some upside. Southern Sky flew late off a moderate tempo at Bathurst last start and is worth including.

Race Analysis: Surprised to see the market the other way around in this one with the form that Agent Zero possesses. He ran behind subsequent Group winner Snitzel Dancer first-up at Hawkesbury before talking the G3 Carbine Club and G3 Frank Packer Plate in recent efforts. Comes back to the mile now which is a query, but his first-up effort rates highly and he makes plenty of appeal. Hammoon Heroine was very good fresh, taking up the running as a \$1.60 pop at Kembla and leading all of the way. It's easy to think she has more to come with that run under her belt. They look the two to beat with Kindamagic an outside chance having closed strongly to win fresh at Sale. She's a nice horse on the rise and is worth following.

Race Analysis: Keen to go around the early favourite in Trooper and side with Matchsticks who comes here first-up. She's trialed well coming into this around some handy types most recently and the inside draw can see her up on the speed from the outset. She was an impressive track and trip winner last campaign, and she looks ready to take the next step this time in work. Button Up is a progressive type who should appreciate coming back to Country level. A small field should see him get every chance and he creates some interest with the unknowns he brings into this. Shoreman has been rock solid around a similar mark recently, though that rates a level below what Matchsticks and Button Up bring into this.

Race Analysis: Plenty of excitement around Dupli Kate on resumption today. She's had two trials in readiness for this and was very good first-up as a 30-1 chance at Warwick Farm last campaign behind the handy Tuileries, before winning a BM82 as a \$1.75 chance easily. Everything looks to work out nicely for her here with McDougall in the saddle and she can pick up from where she left off. Teylu is racing well without winning and his form was franked in the Wagga Town Plate through runner-up Love Shuck. He's a speedy customer and Boudvillain will give a bold sight from the front, though there doesn't appear much edge in his price. Keikoku is a consistent galloper who can't be left out of calculations.
