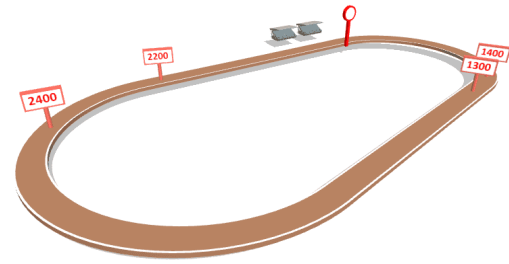

**Race Analysis:** We head back onto the Acton today and Vainstream looks the one to beat in the first. His past couple bring in strong figures, winning on the turf course here a fortnight ago in this same grade of race, and doing so comfortably. He held his own in a tougher race last time out and while he carries the big weight, he deserves to be favourite. I don't really want to pin him too short though with Magic Bertie right back in grade today in his first run for the Tash Burleigh stable. He goes from a BM66 at Wagga most recently down to a BM50 and he does possess some early speed, which is a bonus on the Acton surface.

**Race Analysis:** Reel Crystal has been impressive since joining the Nick Olive stable, running up to the rating that saw her break her maiden over this 1900m journey at Traralgon before switching stables. She closed strongly first-up over 1300m and held her own on a tricky track at Wagga where she remained midfield throughout. The draw here is a little tricky, but she's already run up to her Maiden-winning RAS Rating and has threatened to go to the next level in doing so. She now gets her chance to raise the bar. Time For Snow has played the role of bridesmaid all campaign, running up to his best form last start over 1800m at Bathurst. That would be the query, that he doesn't have another gear to find having now run a similar rating a couple of times this campaign, whereas Reel Crystal profiles as though she has another gear to find. The market looks to have missed Manzobeel in early betting. Happy to over look her first couple of runs where she was well back and never featured, bouncing back at Moruya where the blinkers and tongue tie went on. She closed well there and showed some upside. She jumps right out in trip, but her breeding suggests it won't be an issue and the inside draw should see her get every chance to run it out. There's enough there to suggest she should be near the top of the market.

**Race Analysis:** We saw Bjorn bring Isn't She Autumn to Canberra last month and get the job done over the older horses and he's looking to repeat the dose with Modernist in this. She tackled The Debut on the Gold Coast in December and has trialled strongly this time in work. She's showed versatility in her two short course trials, coming from off the speed in her latest outing, but she also sat on the speed in her first trial. She is attractive over Bedda Mia who is now 0/17 and has been beaten in similar races to this at short quotes prior, including Gundagai, Bathurst and Corowa earlier this year. Her form last campaign looks good, though she did fail in a BM50 prior to the break. Her latest trial was solid, but she's had plenty of chances now.

**Race Analysis:** Comic Culture looks a sharp buy from the Rob Potter camp. He brings strong provincial and metropolitan maiden form to this, beaten 2.1L at Warwick Farm when a \$5 chance prior to the break. He's trialled on the Acton track recently and was very impressive, appearing to do it easily from the front. Coming back to country level today is a big tick, he'll be up from the draw and he'll be very hard to run down if he can resume in similar order to how he left last campaign - though the market hasn't missed him! Hold My Drink just missed at the Sapphire Coast first-up, he dipped as an odds-on pop second-up before bouncing back on the Illawarra Grange track at Kembla last time out. The winner of that race has since won impressively at Hawkesbury yesterday in a good push for that form. Needs to go to another level now but it wouldn't surprise if he did. Rosenblum has minor claims on debut after some nice trials coming into this.

**Race Analysis:** Wide open race following the scratching of Ocean Empress. Very Sirius has the upside off a strong last start effort at Goulburn where she closed well over 1100, at Goulburn last time out. The late splits there were good and she now gets the winkers on. She may be spotting them a start, but she rates alongside this field already with the scope to go past them now. Stern Reminder disappointed last time out but started his campaign in good fashion. He should be on the speed from barrier one with Brodie Loy working his way back to form. Not much between he and Written Gold who disappointed fresh but was a \$5 chance in provincial company. Should find this easier and a return to his best form will see him hard to hold out. Platinum Ridge and Jukebox Flyer are both at a similar level.

**Race Analysis:** Teylu was trending the right way earlier this campaign, narrowly missing out in the Wagga Town Plate Prelude before having no luck last time out. The likeable galloper ended up out near Mooseheads he was that wide and couldn't go on - a tale of many Canberran's have told... This looks to set up much nicer for him today from a softer draw and a favourable map. Can get his campaign back on track. Sutton Vella is the 'weight horse' coming into this, dropping 7.5kg from her last start to today. She stuck on well at the Sapphire Coast there and showed some good splits late in the race. Third-up now and looks poised to strike with further improvement up her sleeve. Iowna Benz failed at Orange last time out but beat Teylu the start prior on the turf course here. Has enough speed to roll across from out wide, particularly with the scratching of Getty this morning. Should be in this for a very long way if he can get back to his best. Ragga Ragga is only a Class 1 horse but has spent much of her career racing in better races than his. She's a speedy customer and can make use of the inside barrier. Can put in an improved effort today.
