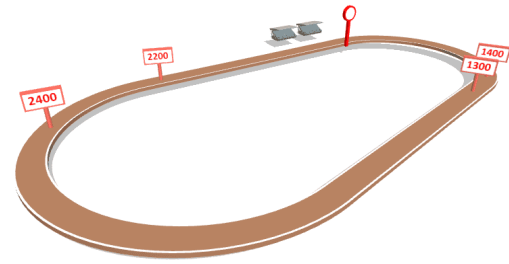

Race Analysis: Not looking to bet in the opener with a few different angles. Geostorm was too good here on the fresh side last start and beat a lot of these in the process. This to shape similarly today, though he's short enough at the price with a few improvers and the fresh blood, which comes in the form of Faerywood. He profiles as a nice horse for a race like this, but the time he ran in his maiden win last start was only fair. Should be prominent from the outset however and can give a bold sight, with not much between he and Geostorm. Beau Rock is drawn out wide but does have the ratings to feature, while Bo Cougar was solid first-up and won't be far away with improvement on the cards.

Race Analysis: Another tricky race to find a way in. Sunburnt Country was very impressive last start when swooping around the outside, but this sets up a little differently. He clocked some good splits late there but comes back in trip today and drawing the inside mightn't be ideal for him. Rates highly off his latest effort, but Timeless Grace has been around that level for a while now without winning. She continues to knock on the door and maybe coming back in trip suits her better than Sunburnt Country, after she was no match for him here a fortnight ago. Highway Robbery may be the one who presents some value. He ran well on debut after being a big drifter in betting and not enjoying the kickback. Getting out to this trip now can see him raise the bar second-up. O Cara Mia was just fair last start when out to 2000m second-up but can feature here, along with Turn Left who hasn't been far away recently.

Race Analysis: We'll look to keep our powder dry again in this. Inspiring was anything but first-up on a wet deck at Wangaratta and tackles the Acton surface for the first time. He showed good speed there though and did jump in the market, but he's very hard to line up here. Spice Alley missed as a \$3.50 chance here a fortnight ago and now draws wider. That makes things a little harder for her and with her ratings hovering around many in this field, it's hard to mark her any shorter even though she appears on an upward trajectory. Charlies and Entirely Oak are similar as well as the market suggests. Roselily may be one the market has overlooked early with some sound formlines coming into this. Wouldn't surprise to see her run a cheeky race.

Race Analysis: Looking to open the wallet and have a bet here with the Joe Pride-trained Opine. He stuck on well on debut over 1200m at Gosford, moving into the race as though he'd challenge for the victory. He may have found them a little sharp there, with the slight rise in trip and drop back to country grade looking very suitable. The horse who won that race is the early favourite for a Stakes race in Queensland on Saturday. Can stay out of trouble from barrier seven and get the job done at start two. While Opine is expected to raise the bar, Monte Braveheart's profile suggests the opposite. The gelding was very impressive off a 490-day break here a fortnight ago, though a deep into his RAS Ratings suggests that he lowers his rating by ~2 lengths when second-up previously. While the return was strong, if history repeats itself, then Opine will be right there to strike. Olivia Mia can build on a solid performance here last time out and can't be discounted from an inside barrier.

Race Analysis: Happy to swing the way of the Vella-trained Flashback Time in this event after a strong return victory, underlined by some impressive splits late in the race. She rates on top after that performance with the splits saying she may have a little more to come now. Nabha joined the Potter stable last start and bounced back to something like her best at Nowra. A soggy deck there may not have helped, but onto firmer footing today can see her improve again. She did break her maiden here as a \$1.85 on Hops & Hooves Day last year and with her early speed, she'll give a bold sight. Cool Blaze makes come appeal coming back to this level and she is a winner on the turf course here previously. Third-up now and coming back to Country level looks a recipe for success. Diamond Frost and Jimmy's Ready are both on resumption and showed glimpses of talent early in their respective careers.

Race Analysis: This is a cracking race, though they're all very evenly matched and that makes it hard to find a way in. Ellismayne is racing well in tougher company and looks well placed coming back to this level and he has shown versatility in his career thus far. Smashing Lulu is a must for Quaddie punters. She has a strong record and was impressive when carrying the big weight as a 3YO to score in a BM58 before the fresher. Maps for a kind run and is worth keeping on side, while Diamond Frost scratches from an earlier race to line up here and his best ratings stack right up.

Race Analysis: Waiting until the last for the Best Bet of the day with Vella's Best. He's much better than Federal grade and he showed that last start when leading and running well in a BM78 at Randwick, finishing behind the handy Ice Kool who has since won again. The claim of Sinclair comes in handy here and the task looks straight forward for her with his early speed. He should lead from the inside barrier and will be tough to run down even with the big weight. Pleasurize and Iowna Benz are similar horses on ratings and should be treated similarly. Expecting Iowna Benz to roll across from out wide and Pleasurize to get the nice run in transit from in behind the speed. Famoso trialled very nicely here recently and profiles nicely for a Federal. He worked through the grades nicely last campaign before failing in Highway company before the break. Looks to have come back as good - if not better - and must be included. King Gutho seems to be disrespected in early betting. He's a quality horse with an impressive first-up record. 0/2 at this track and trip, but a horse of his quality can't be discounted.
