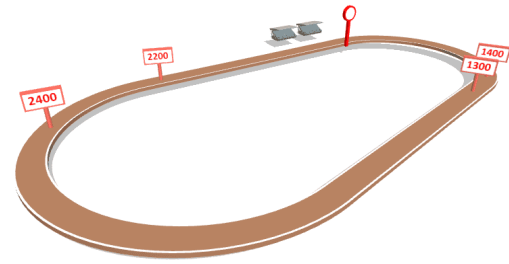

Race Analysis: Spice Alley is the one to beat on exposed form, finishing 2.3L off the winner at Nowra before the break. Budler and Potter are combining with success recently and things look to work out well for her on the map. The unknowns surrounding the debutants is a tad scary, though she's shown enough in her debut campaign to suggest she's a deserving favourite here. Barefootinthesnow and The Ultimate Star should be treated similarly as they come through the same trial with only a length and change between them there. The inside barrier and JVO is a good push for Barefootinthesnow and he was better than The Ultimate Star late in that trial. They look the three with Monte Braveheart produced here off a very long break and I suspect they'll be too sharp for him first-up.

Race Analysis: Timeless Grace has been knocking on the door for a while now and continues to bang up strong ratings in defeat. The form out of her last start at Albury is very strong, with three winners already coming out of that race from 8 starters since. A better draw here helps and the form she's in currently has her on top. Mamma Mia won well fresh at Goulburn but hasn't been to that level since when tackling stronger races. She's trialled well between runs and her rating when winning fresh stacks up. She profiles as an improver here, but there's not much edge in her price now following scratchings.

Race Analysis: Another open race where it's hard to have a strong opinion. Stablemates Tatay Bay and Big Time Charlie profile strongly for this and Tatay Bay boasts the highest rating within the last 50 days of this field - and by some margin. Big Time Charlie continued his winning ways and has the speed to lead and dictate from an outside draw for JVO and he continues to raise the bay. That A Boy posted a strong rating first-up before going to town last start and being outclassed. Back to this level is a big tick and he's right in this if he can bounce back to the form he showed fresh. Turn Left finished strongly off a moderate tempo last time out and that effort suggests there's another level for her to go to.

Race Analysis: Thinking Neeson could be the one to zero in on after a strong performance in Highway company last start, after bumping into Atmospheric Rock at Wagga first-up. He jumped a \$4.80 chance fresh and the sticky draw forces Boudvillain's hand as he should roll forward from out there. Third-up now, he's run a strong figure last time and with further improvement in store, it wouldn't surprise to see him jump an odds-on chance. Comic Culture was backed as if he'd already won last start and just held on. The inside barrier here is a big tick as he'll be prominent from the outset again and if he can raise the bar again second-up, he'll be tough to reel in.
