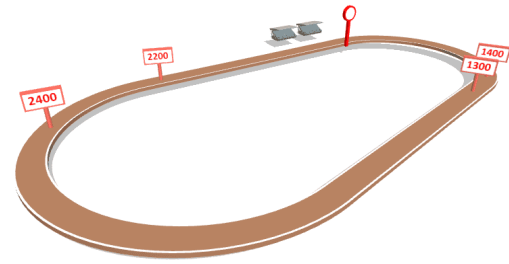

Race Analysis: Keen to take on the early favourite Jenni Moo Moo. While she will find this easier than what she's been racing in when in the Ciaron Maher camp, though the ratings she's run in those efforts aren't anything to write home about. She's now right back to 1000m where she hasn't been since a 2YO and could end up in a tricky position from the inside barrier. Gratz Vella has a strong hand in this race, with Xtrascent putting in a big figure over this track and trip first-up. He led on that occasion and I suspect Guymmer will try and adopt similar tactics. The figure he put up fresh is better than anything Jenni has put up in the last 12 months and if he can find the front, he'll take plenty of catching. Kip Star - also for Vella - is a 2YO taking on the older horses and was strong late in the race on debut. Should be better for that effort and with natural improvement expected, he can be there at the finish.

Race Analysis: Another race where I'm looking to take on the early favourite. The rating of Unmatched from his last start effort stands out in this field where he plugged away at Newcastle. The form out of that race has stood up since and he'll find this an easier race. Now with the local stable, so he'll be used to the Acton surface. Should be able to take closer order today and would just have to repeat his most recent performance to get the job done. Turn Left stuck on well behind an in-form galloper last start over 1750m and stepping out to this distance now won't be a problem. She had absolutely every chance last start and looked to have the race won at the top of the straight, yet couldn't put the race away in the final 200m. That makes it hard to forecast that she's got more under the bonnet. Behind those, Ridgeback, Bo Cougar and Webejamin all have profiles that could see them improvement out to this distance.

Race Analysis: Happy to give this race a wide berth. Step Quick disappointed last start and while his prior ratings stack up, he has had 18 goes at it now and is yet to land the knockout blow, including SP's of \$3.30, \$2.60, \$2.20 and \$6 at his last four outings. Skibidi is no world beater but finds the right race on the back of a solid resuming effort. Legsliketwiggy is a 5YO on debut but she impressed in her only trial coming in. She makes some appeal on debut, though the wide draw is the big query.

Race Analysis: This shapes as a very good race. Olivia Mia was a very good winner at this track and trip last start when sitting closer, notching up her maiden victory. While it was visually impressive, it was actually a slower time than what Diamond Frost ran when scoring later on in the card - but not by much. Midnight Moose jumped favourite in a BM74 first-up and didn't have much luck when buried in the pack and ended up finishing behind She Conquers there. The market has them priced similarly in this one. Wolf Island drops some weight for this race after flashing late in a Class 1 here last time out. Will need a touch of luck from the barrier with his racing pattern, but if the gaps come he can feature in the finish. Plenty of chances but hopefully it'll end up being a strong form reference moving forward.

Race Analysis: This looks an open Federal and it shows on the ratings too. Sutton Vella, Craving Magic and Ravalli are all evenly matched and have been doing battle in Federal's recently, with Ravalli stepping out to this trip for the first time for the Potter stable. He draws the inside and looks to be building toward a win, but it's hard to say he's going any better than Craving Magic or Sutton Vella. Different Form may come to the fore here and that comes in the shape of Atmospheric Rock who was scratched from the Federal here a month ago. He continues to be outclassed in Saturday grade in Sydney, but he can fire when coming back to country grade as he showed just three starts ago at Wagga when beating a subsequent Acton winner in Neeson. He makes the most appeal for me at the early price.

Race Analysis: Sunburnt Country has knocked me over the last two efforts, coming back to this distance and saluting last time out. While he's in winning form, he's running a similar rating and that makes me think he may be closer to his ceiling than a horse like Col Du Tourmalet who is a lightly raced galloper who seems to be on the rise. Out to 1750m looks a good move with the way he finished off last start, pulling away late with good strength. Thinking he has another level to go to and that makes him an attractive commodity in this event. Taytay Bay has figures that are similar to Sunburnt Country and Col Du Tourmalet but lacks the upside of those two. Still banging up consistent performances though and is not to be taken lightly. Bombelleistic is third-up now and is well placed here third-up into the campaign. Roonami isn't the worst \$26 chance I've ever seen either. She didn't handle the going last start and her profile suggests she'll eat up the extra trip.
