Race Analysis: Happy to open the wallet here with Ho Aloha who rates on top following a 1.6L defeat at Hawkesbury most recently. Her run two back in country grade at Nowra was solid and again prior to that at Goulburn. While she is 0/11, she's spent a lot of her time in stronger company, and the wide draw doesn't hurt too much. JVO can track the speed across from the wide draw and just has to run up to her latest rating to get the job done. Wild Romeo comes here first-up and is one of the speed influences in the race. Expecting him to roll forward from the gate for Loy and the SP's from his debut campaign show the ability he has. Would have to run a new peak first-up which isn't out of the question, but it is hard to forecast. Forgive Me Father trialed well around some handy types coming into his debut and is worth keeping safe.

Race Analysis: Excited for the return of Royaltown who shaped as one to follow through his debut campaign. He was impressive on debut before sticking on well in defeat on a wet deck at Goulburn before the break. That effort suggested he was up to Highway company, and he's found a suitable race for his return. He should get every chance from the inside barrier and if he can pick up from where he left off, he can return on a winning note. There's not much between Famoso and Olivia Mia on the ratings. Famoso stuck on well fresh in Federal company and now comes back to a CL2 in a more suitable assignment. His trial leading in was superb, so he's not to be discounted. Prinzerro creates some interest back in grade, but happy to back in the Pepper stable and the upside of Royaltown who looks a nice horse on resumption.

Race Analysis: Craving Magic goes on top despite a poor one last time out. He was building nicely prior to that performance and back out to 1280m here looks a good move. There's plenty to like about him, though it's the resuming Mighty Myrtle who makes the most appeal at the price. She tackled some strong Federals last campaign before ending up in the Bega Cup and then the Country Championship Qualifiers. That form stands out in this field where a lot of these have been racing each other. Drawing off the fence is ideal for her, allowing her to build into the race and swing down the outside. I was keen on Atmospheric Rock last start, and he was solid late in the race. Out to this distance now should help him, though he will be a long way back in the run. Brooklyn Lights showed enough last campaign to suggest she's no slouch and has to be respected.

Race Analysis: Olivia Mia lines up here rather than earlier in the card and she creates interest out to 1750m for the first time. She bumped into a smart one most recently when jumping the race favourite, closing nicely to be 0.6L off the winner. The rise in trip is the query, but her breeding and the way she closed off last start suggests it won't be an issue. Needs a scratching to gain a start and she creates plenty of interest if she does. Remadosi is another who creates interest despite a couple of poor runs to begin the campaign. This is a completely different scenario however, out to this track and trip where she has been placed previously. Everything points to a much-improved performance, and a strong case can be made. Webejamin can find the front and will take some catching.
