



Tipping Competition at Thoroughbred Park - Canberra Racing Club:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Who can enter:

The Thoroughbred Park - Canberra Racing Club (the Club) tipping competition is open to current financial members only.

The Club reserves the right to request proof of identity.

Opening/closing dates & times:

The Competition runs on race days from 1 July 2019 continuously until the Club ends the term of the Competition. The Club will notify members via email at least two months prior to the competition ending.

For each Competition, the Club will publish the nominated race date and open the Competition for entries by no later than 1:00pm on the date two days prior to the nominated race date.

Entries are submitted for each Competition via the Thoroughbred Park Website. Entries to the Competition will always close prior to the start of the first of the six nominated races for the given Competition.

How to enter:

To enter a Competition, go to www.thoroughbredpark.com.au, select the Members Tipping Competition. Click the 'Tip Now' button; Fill in your details; Enter your horse numbers in the fields; Submit your tips.

Select one runner from each race and follow the instructions on the web page to submit your entry. Once the entries have closed, entrants cannot change their selections for the Competition.

Entrants must submit their final selections prior to the closing time specified for each week of the Competition.

By entering selections, the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions. Any information published at the Entry Points about the Competition form part of these Terms and Conditions.

The Club reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any entrant who the Club reasonably believes has breached any of these Terms and Conditions.

If any selection is a late scratching (scratching's are finalised on race morning) in any race then the starter with the lowest saddlecloth number is substituted e.g. if horse number 5 is selected and is scratched it will be replaced by horse number 1 and if horse number 1 is also scratched it will be replaced by horse number 2 and so on.

If less than 4 races are run on any program (due postponement/abandonment) than no winners will be announced for that race meeting and \$250 credit will be added to the next race meeting's prize.

Cost of entry:

Entry to the Competition is free.

Maximum number of entries:

Only one entry is allowed per Member, per Competition. Multiple entries will void all entries for the Member.

Prize and Points System:

Points will be awarded to selections that place as follows in any event:

1st – 3 points,

2nd – 2 points,

3rd – 1 point.

Points will be awarded irrespective of the number of horses in any race. For Competition purposes, the placings for each race are as determined by Stewards at the time that correct weight is declared for any event.

At the conclusion of any standard race day (all race days excluding Black Opal Stakes Day and Canberra Community Chest Day), where 4 or more races have been run, the Member with the most points accumulated is determined as the winner and will have \$250 credit applied to their membership card.

Should there be Members on equal points, the Member with the most 1st placings amongst their selections will be determined the outright winner and if there is still no outright winner, the Member with the most 2nd placings will then be determined the outright winner.

If after 1st and 2nd placings are assessed and there is still no outright winner, the winning prize (credit) will be divided equally amongst the winning members.

Winners of the credit, will receive an additional 20% if they were to scan their membership card at Thoroughbred Park terminals when purchasing food and beverage on the same day.

Credit will expire in the Membership season (July to June) that it is won, with the exception of credit won in June which will be rolled over to the next Membership season.

Bonus Prize:

If any member correctly selects the final six winners, aligned with these Terms and Conditions, that Member will receive a complimentary \$1,000 free bet on the follow meeting's TAB Federal.

If there is no TAB Federal at the following meeting, the free bet will apply on the next meeting where a TAB Federal is held.

If multiple members correctly select the final six winners, the \$1,000 will be divided evenly.

Winners of this prize must provide the selection via email to canberraracing@thoroughbredpark.com.au, prior to 11am on the relevant race day. If no correspondence is received, the bonus prize is forfeited.

The free bet must be placed on the TAB Federal as one bet on the Win market at the local fixed odds.

The free bet will be placed by Club officials when the first on-course TAB facility opens.

The Club bears no responsibility on disparity of selections odds, should this change in between the correspondence being received and the bet being placed.

If the winner's selection is a late scratching, the bet will roll over to the following meeting, where the preceding terms and conditions apply.

If the winner's free bet is a winner, they will receive the entirety of the earnings including the \$1,000 stake.

Winner notification:

The names of any outright winner will be published on the website.

Winners will be notified by email within 2 working days and winning credits applied to the winners.

Prize fulfilment:

Prizes will be paid via deposit to each winner's via bank transfer to a bank account nominated by the winner within 21 days of the winner selection.

Membership account in this timeframe:

It is each entrant's sole responsibility to ensure that their contact details are up to date.

Winners will be required to verify (with evidence satisfactory to the Club) their identity and other requested verification information to the satisfaction of the Club before they are eligible to receive a prize.

Any public announcement will be pending verification unless otherwise stated and should not be considered final confirmation.

If a winning entrant is not able, for any reason to accept a prize, verify their registration information to the satisfaction of the Club or has been found to have breached these terms and conditions by the Club then the entrant will be disqualified and the prize will be forfeited.

Credits won through this competition will not expire provided the Member remains a financial member of the Club. Should the membership lapse than any credits won through this competition will be forfeited. Credits won through this competition can be used to purchase food and beverages from any Thoroughbred Park outlet on any race day.

Publicity & privacy:

If you enter the Competition you agree that the Club may include and/or announce on the Thoroughbred Park website, on social media platforms and/or elsewhere at their discretion your membership number and details of any prizes that you have won and/or correct selections that you have made.

You also agree to do all things reasonably requested by the Club if you win any prizes, including by complying with the Club's reasonable request to use your name, likeness and/or voice in promotional material. You agree that all such material belongs to the Club and can be used for any length of time at its discretion.

Disputes:

If an entrant wishes to dispute the published outcome of a Competition they must do so within three days of the Competition by email to canberraracing@thoroughbredpark.com.au. The Board of the Club will be the sole arbiter of any such dispute.
