His late speed was impressive off a moderate tempo, and he looks an improver getting out beyond a mile for the first time in his career. Maps for a lovely run and rates as the main danger. Expecting a better run from Bella Piazza, though last start rated higher than his maiden which is the query.

Race Analysis: Erin Ellison has made a bright start to her career and with plenty of praise from good judges - there's no reason to shy away from one the 4kg claimer is riding. Star Empire sets up nicely here with his early speed, drawing the inside and he should be able to hold out his rivals. The claim comes in handy and the form he brings from tougher races last campaign stacks right up in this field. He's expected to give a bold sight. Wolf Island doesn't win out of turn, but the talent still appears to be there. Needs a few things to go his way, but his best form is good enough and he can recapture that back in this grade. Merchant Reign landed a good plunge here last start, but this sets up differently. Happy to take him on now out in trip and from a wide draw.

Race Analysis: Happy to leave this race alone and learn something out of it. The wide draw is the big query as he hasn't shown blistering speed from the barriers. Will need a touch of luck but he looks to have good ability. Three Wishes was good here last start when sticking on from the one-out-one-back position and can't be discounted with Shaun Guymer now on board.

Race Analysis: Keen to bet in this race as the ratings and splits are telling me Remadosi is the one. Had no luck two back and was strong late in the race last start when edged out in a photo by stablemate Bombelleistic. They carry the same weight today, though the rise in trip and anticipated tempo of the race may suit Remadosi better. Bombelleistic is racing in top order and maps for a similar run to his last two efforts at this track - both saw him come out victorious. The form of their last start looks strong, but with another favourable set up, he must come into calculations. Sunburnt Country also gets a better set up this time. He couldn't reel in Bombelleistic and Remadosi last time but shouldn't be spotting them as much of a start this time. County Kilkenny's recent form has been strong when leading and he can dictate the tempo from up front. Happy to take on Marsabit as favourite who hasn't won for over 1000 days.

Race Analysis: Ravalli comes up the favourite in a Sprinters Cup where there's not much between them on the RAS Ratings. He'd been knocking on the door prior to tackling midweek company last start and his SP's prior show he was on the right path, edged out in a photo finish here just three back. Looks to get plenty in his favour again here back to that same track and trip and he's an easy one to stamp as favourite. Atmospheric Rock always needs things to go his way and he's a hard one to dive into. Won well at Forbes last time and was good here prior but will need some things to go his way from back in the pack. I thought the value lied with Lambay who lobs here first-up for Barb & the boys. He contested the Country Champs qualifiers at the end of last campaign and held his own in open sprints prior. Has enough tactical speed to put himself into the race and can make an impression on his return.

Race Analysis: Famoso jumped a \$21 chance last start in midweek company after jumping in the market over 1280m here two starts ago. He trialled well coming into the campaign and was in the market in a Federal over this course and distance, so coming back to a CL2 makes him very appealing. May need some luck in running but his ratings stack right up in this field. Must Be Sain jumped an odds-on chance here two back and was far too good in a BM60. This is a little tougher now but that's still worth plenty. Watch for him late. Super Infinity returns from Hong Kong and hasn't been sighted since returning to Australia. Form in Hong Kong was solid without winning. He can feature.
