Race Analysis: Give Me Joy bolted in last start when first-up for the new stable and the figures out of that were very strong, but things may play out a little differently here with the engagement of Zou Royal. The only time we've seen Zou Royal at country level was a 3.1L victory at Bathurst in November and two back bumped into subsequent Midway winner Attractiveness at Newcastle. She was good late at Canterbury last start and now drops right back to a country level Class 2 and I suspect she'll try and hold her position up front from the inside draw. Lightly raced and looks beautifully placed on her latest efforts. No real knocks on Give Me Joy after that impressive last start win, she just mightn't find the front as easy as she did last time out. Must Be Sain was impressive last start but is some query out in trip being 0/5 at 1200m.

Race Analysis: This looks to be shaping as a good maiden on paper. Lavender Rose started her career with the Bjorn Baker stable, trialling four times and placing in the latest heat at Rosehill back in September last year. She hasn't been sighted publicly since then, but now lobs for the Pepper barn with strike hoop JVO engaged. 11 months out of sight is the query, but she looks to have good talent on what we have seen and she commands plenty of respect. I did think La Stiava should be a little closer in the market however after some positive showings in her 2YO campaign. She jumped a \$3.10 chance and then a \$5 elect in the Black Opal Preview when beaten by Music Time on both occasions. Cahill is usually the strike jockey for the Gardner barn and the gate will see her stay out of trouble in the run. She's shown enough to suggest she won't be a maiden for too long. Deeply won't be far away if she can resume at a level close to her best.

Race Analysis: Keen to be in the corner of Action King here on the back of an impressive first-up performance at Doomben. He missed in a photo there, but the form out of it has been impressive with two winners from 4 subsequent starts since. Erin Ellison has hit the ground running as a 4kg claimer and her riding style and form suggests she won't have that claim for long - so we better jump on the bandwagon while she still does! Things look to work out nicely for Action King here and a repeat effort will see him go one better. I though Cougars should be a clear second pick on the form he brings in. He went throught the Country Championship Qualifiers before a solid effort from the front during the Wagga carnival. Back from a break here, she has early speed and Quince's 2kg claim means he carries no weight. There's enough boxes ticked to say she can fire. Sunrise Ridge comes through the same race as Zou Royal (race 1) - so we'll get a good luck at that form early. She's been campaigned like a good horse and won't be far away on her recent form.

Race Analysis: Siding with the 'fresh blood' here - although they have won similar races recently. The race Tillman won last start has its knocks with Tillman a \$31 chance and with the first six across the line only 2.5L apart. That throws up Bombelleistic and Sunburnt Country as the two and could be marked shorter on that basis. Ratings say Bombelleistic should be favourite - particularly with the set up her gets here from the inside barrier. He wasn't disgraced when dropping back to the mile at Wyong last time adfter a gutsy win here prior, beating Sunburnt Country in a race that shapes similarly. Wouldn't surprise to see Bombelleistic have another gear now, although the weight swing does favour Sunburnt Country. He was solid out to 2400m last start, but he returns to the scene of his best performance here and did jump an odds-on favourite over Bombelleistic two starts ago. They look the main chances. If I was going to take anything out of the Tillman race, it would be Remadosi who didn't have luck at a crucial stage last time. If Krogh can get her out and rolling a little earlier, she can make her presence felt.
