

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THOROUGHbred PARK

Managed by Canberra Racing Club Incorporated (CRC)

Entry to Thoroughbred Park constitutes acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. All patrons entering the venue agree to comply with these conditions and any lawful directions issued by Canberra Racing Club, its staff, security personnel or authorised representatives.

General Conditions

- Management reserves the right to inspect and search bags, containers and personal items on entry or exit from the premises.
- Entry to Thoroughbred Park is conditional upon patrons consenting to reasonable bag inspections and security screening.
- Persons gaining unauthorised access to Thoroughbred Park may be evicted and liable for prosecution.
- Persons who lawfully gain entry and pass tickets, passes or accreditation to others outside the venue may be evicted and have the relevant tickets, passes or accreditation confiscated.
- Patrons must comply with all lawful directions issued by CRC staff, security personnel, stewards, emergency services personnel or authorised contractors.
- Patrons who use offensive, threatening or abusive language, engage in disorderly behaviour, cause a disturbance or refuse to comply with directions may be removed from the venue.
- Alcohol must not be brought into or removed from Thoroughbred Park unless authorised by CRC.
- Persons who damage, vandalise or interfere with venue infrastructure may be evicted and liable for prosecution and/or recovery of costs.
- Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied and appropriately supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Patrons bringing personal items into Thoroughbred Park do so at their own risk. CRC accepts no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal property. A lost property register is maintained by management.
- Patrons who park vehicles within Thoroughbred Park or associated parking areas do so at their own risk. Canberra Racing Club accepts no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to vehicles or their contents.
- To the extent permitted by law, CRC accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage sustained by patrons while attending the venue.

- Any unauthorised commercial activity including ticket selling, soliciting, customer surveying, promotions or attaching advertisements to any surface is prohibited.
- Entry tickets remain the property of CRC and may not be resold or transferred without written approval.
- Media representatives must obtain accreditation from CRC prior to attending or entering Thoroughbred Park for any media-related purpose.

Restricted Areas and Horse Safety

- Patrons must not enter any stable, horse training, mounting yard, horse pathway, barriers area, racetrack, trackwork area or other restricted operational area unless authorised by CRC.
- Patrons who enter restricted areas without authorisation may be evicted and liable for prosecution.
- Patrons must not touch, feed, harass, startle or otherwise interfere with any horse or animal on the premises.
- Patrons must comply with all signage and directions relating to horse movements and restricted areas.
- Patrons who throw articles onto the racing surface or into any horse-related area may be evicted and liable for prosecution.

Privacy and Recording

- By entering Thoroughbred Park, patrons acknowledge that photographs, video and audio recordings may be taken for security,

operational, promotional and marketing purposes.

- Patrons consent to the use of their image, likeness and voice by CRC and its authorised partners without compensation.

Refusal of Entry and Removal

- Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any person deemed intoxicated, disorderly or suspected of being under the influence of illegal substances.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any unauthorised, excluded or warned-off person.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any patron attempting to bring restricted or prohibited items into the venue.
- Management reserves the right to remove any person who breaches these Conditions of Entry without refund.
- Management reserves the right to remove any person engaging in anti-social behaviour.

Restricted and Prohibited Items

- Alcoholic beverages, illicit drugs, glass or breakable containers.
- Flares, fireworks, laser pointers, knives, dangerous weapons or any item that may cause injury or public nuisance.
- Balloons, confetti, streamers and similar items unless approved by management.
- Whistles, air horns or any item likely to unreasonably disrupt the enjoyment of other patrons.

- Spray cans or compressed air canisters.
- Animals, except accredited assistance animals.
- Skateboards, scooters, roller blades, bicycles or similar devices.
- Recording devices used for commercial purposes without approval.
- Flags, banners or signage that obstruct views, present a safety risk or contain offensive, political, religious or commercial messaging.
- Commercial goods or items intended for sale unless approved by management.
- Unauthorised drones, remotely piloted aircraft or similar devices.

Food and Beverage

- Patrons must not bring external food, beverages or catering into Thoroughbred Park. All food and beverage consumed within the venue must be purchased from Canberra Racing Club.

Smoking and Vaping

- Smoking and vaping are only permitted in designated outdoor smoking areas.
- Patrons must comply with all signage and directions relating to smoking and vaping restrictions.
- Management reserves the right to remove any person who fails to comply with our smoking and vaping policy.

Liquor Licensing

- All persons entering Thoroughbred Park acknowledge that they are entering licensed premises.

- It is an offence for minors to purchase or consume liquor.
- It is an offence to purchase liquor for, or supply liquor to, a minor.
- Persons supplying liquor to minors may be reported to Police and penalties apply under the Liquor Act 2010 (ACT).

Emergency Procedures

- In the event of an emergency, patrons must follow all directions provided by venue staff, security personnel or emergency services.
