CMON' WICKSY was okay two back at Moruya but has been jumping at huge prices. Hard to entertain with confidence, though he could cause a scare.

If we get evens we can play ball. MIGHTY MYRTLE is yet to prove herself at the mile but the way she's been finishing off this campaign suggests she might be able to give this a shake. Miss S is mainly a reliable mare for the Olive camp and could give the shorty another scare. SPURLINE has notched up all three of his wins over the mile but is likely to land in a tricky spot from the low draw. Lightweight flyer.

Loves the trip and gets much-needed weight relief. He couldn't, could he? TAI LUNG also sheds a stack of weight after missing by a head at Moruya. Drawn sticky but isn't hopeless at a big quote. BEER BARON shoot for the hat-trick and could be a knockout hope late if they completely overcook it in front. Can see VB stealing a break and Action King launching at him late. The King on the line.

Race Analysis: Connections of JUDITH'S REVENGE can count themselves a touch unlucky not to have enjoyed more success. She has her doubters but rarely runs a bad one. Another narrow defeat brought first-up heartbreak at Wagga, with a big gap back to third. Her partner in crime Cahill takes back over and she draws to get every favour from the inside. Clearly the one to beat, though her habit of finding one or two better remains the knock. KENDALIA is crying out for a breakthrough and ran well behind a sharply improved Cholante here two weeks ago. Needs to find a little more to get the job done. FAMOSO's form is patchy but shoulders peaks that can measure up. KOOL KADE beat Judith's Revenge at Wagga but meets her significantly worse at the weights. Suspect that makes the task too tough this time.
