Roonami finds this a fair bit easier but has the weight to contend with, while the draw adds another hurdle.

Race Analysis: Not too often we see them this short in the Federal but it does look Matty Dale's for the taking with Rose Aye. Dropping back from Sydney Saturday company. she took a really strong account FU when firm in the market, then had excuses last time after an awkward jump. Races best when ridden aggressively and under the light weight of Cole's claim, I suspect they will do just that and prove very tough to reel in. Graceful Ellen kicks off her climb to the Kozzy and is drawn to stalk them into it. Will appreciate a strong tempo and will be riding shotgun if Rose Aye overdoes it. Cholante was a sharp improver here in her second start under Lukey Pepper. She can continue to improve but is up against it here.

If she gets her own way in front, she could take some reeling in. Prophet Time doesn't win out of turn but is up to this at her best. Heywood's booking is a positive on the short turnaround. The old boy Vainstream lines up for start 116 on a four-day backup and is in the mix after a good effort at Leeton.

Race Analysis: Tricky finish. Prestige Prince caught the eye late on debut last year before spelling. Trialled nicely ahead of this prep but had excuses after racing wide throughout on return. A better draw should give him a cheaper run and something up his sleeve when they quicken. Hellfire Henry showed promise in his debut prep and also trialled well ahead of this campaign, but went amiss at Hawkesbury. Could be worth another look with that run behind him. Entirely Oak has had plenty of chances. Don't Back Down gets a key booking in Heywood for her stable debut, so keeping an eye out for late support. Debutant Flying Maurice is hard to get a handle on.
