Race Analysis: Feazabeel should've won by a space three back at Goulburn but was eased up late and only scored by 0.3L. He's been knocked over twice since at Scone, with both of those over 1700m. He now gets Loy on board replacing the apprentice hoop in a big push for his chances and things look to work out nicely for him. Hinting that he's got another level to go to, and he might put it all together in this event. Give Me Joy has raced since her fresh run - though she was deemed a non-runner on the Acton track after an issue on jumping. She'd still be out to 1600m for the first time either way, and that's a niggle with all her form past 1300m disappointing. She might be a different horse now though, but she's had enough goes to suggest she mightn't see out the mile. Miss Stalwart had no luck last start when working into the race and finds a suitable event to return to her best form.

Race Analysis: Keen to back the debutant Sweet Harry. The trial form he brings in is superb, trialling around Rattle The Stars who was great on debut at Hawkesbury. and beating Barrengarry in his latest trial who won in Saturday grade at Rosehill and was competitive in the G3 Frank Packer Plate. He's got early speed; it looks like he's got good ability and this is a suitable race on his home deck to make a statement. Defiance is next best in his debut run for the Luke Pepper stable after racing for Bjorn Baker to begin his career. He was right in the market at both Wyong and Hawkesbury last campaign, and Loy riding is a big tick. Has the speed to work across from out wide and can be in this for a very long way. Highwire Artist jumped favourite in the Clan O'Sullivan on the back of a nice trial. Hasn't been sighted since but he's an exciting galloper on resumption.

Race Analysis: Was keen to back Beautiful You with Wendell in the market, and now that he's scratched the door looks wide open. Beautiful You was superb on debut at Wyong, edged out on the line when leading. She looks set to take up the running again under Fitzgerald from an inside barrier and she brings in the highest last start rating. Everything points to further improvement here with the debut run under her belt and she'll be hard to reign in from the front. Ring Of Fire was solid on resumption at Goulburn and the booking of McDougall is a big push. Will stalk the speed throughout and be there if good enough, but he'll need to do something he hasn't done in his first eight starts.

Race Analysis: A few chances. Hurry Miss has spent much of this campaign racing in town and now comes back to Federal company with only 55.5kg on her back. While she's not threatening in town, she hasn't been disgraced and she's still got enough runs on the board to be a threat in the Country Champs next year. Her Highway run fresh is an ideal piece of form for this and she can get back to winning ways. Cougars was just fair first-up in the Sprinters Cup on the Acton, but he does improve with racing. The blinkers going on today is a good push for his chances, as is the booking of Boudvillain. Ticks plenty of boxes and can improve quickly. Alottosay was solid in town first-up and is well placed in this race. Can feature in the finish despite the wide alley.

Race Analysis: Not sure how to play the last, but I think the top two should be a little closer in betting. Pure Melody got out over further last campaign but her form around this trip was sound and at a solid level. First-up with McDougall booked is an ominous sign for her rivals and if she can return in similar order, she'll be hard to fend off. Kendalia was trending the right way before disappointing on the heavy deck at Moruya last time. Her form prior only matches was Pure Melody did last campaign, though it's the race fitness that could be important. Cholante can improve with the fresh run out of the way after a long break and Gem Tycoon should get every chance off the inside.
